It is a big question – one that requires careful thought about changing program requirements, new service delivery methods, and future funding models.

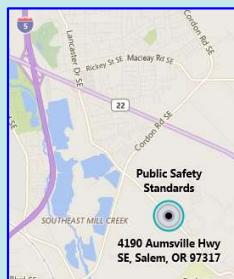
