Officer ID: bbillings, Initial Summary Narrative

Report by Officer Bill Billings November 7, 2018

On Wednesday, November 7, 2018 at about 1300 hours, I contacted the administrative staff about an assault investigation that I learned (patrol case# 18-123456) had occurred in one of the boy's bathrooms at County H.S., on Wednesday, November 7, 2018 during the lunch time. This assault investigation involved several students and I was assisted by Vice Principals Smith and Dean of Students, Wilson. We learned that a video had been circulated on social media and later we were able to identify several County H.S. students from this video.

Vice Principal Smith and I contacted **Bryan Ricker** at County H.S. on Wednesday 11/7/18 and he told us the following statements:

- Jack and I got back right at the end of lunch.
- Samuel met us at the school entrance and said something about some new graffiti in the boys bathroom.
- We all went to the bathroom to see.
- I entered the stall and got kicked from behind. I turned around and Joey started punching me in the face.
- The fight didn't last long, I didn't have a chance to defend myself before Joey ran off.
- Jack and I went to the office to get some help for my bloody nose.
- I figured he was still pissed about me not letting him come to lunch in my car without chipping in gas money.
- On a pain scale of 1-10, with 1 being no pain and 10 being the worst pain ever, Bryan stated the pain to his face and eye area was about a 7.
I noticed that Bryan had a swollen left eye that was starting to show coloration of bruising and a cut to his lip.

Vice Principal Smith and I contacted **Jack Brown** at County H.S. on 11/07/18 and he told us the following statements:

- Bryan and I were going off campus for lunch, in Bryan's car.
- Bryan wouldn't let Joey in his car unless he paid him some gas money. Joey didn't have any but he got in anyway.
- Bryan got out of the driver's seat and pulled Joey out of the car, shoving him to the ground.
- Me and Bryan went to lunch.
- When we returned from lunch, Samuel met us outside the school and told us that "you should come see the new graffiti that's on the wall in the boy's bathroom".
- We all went into the bathroom.
- I saw Joey but Bryan didn't. I immediately knew what was going on but couldn't warn Bryan in time.
- I couldn't see because the stall door was in the way, but thought Joey was kicking or punching Bryan while Samuel made a video on his phone.
- The fight lasted 5 seconds.
- Joey and Samuel left the bathroom.
- Bryan had a bloody nose and lip and it looked like his eye was swelling up.
- I took Bryan to the office nurse.

Vice Principal Smith and I contacted **Samuel Johnson** at County H. S. on 11/07/18 and he told us the following statements:

- I was walking out the front doors of the school when Joey was walking in.
- Joey told me that Bryan threw him out of his car which caused him to rip a hole in his jeans just because he couldn't chip in any gas money.
- Joey was pissed about the scuffle and said "I'm gonna beat Bryan's ass when he gets back to school".
- I felt bad for Joey so I asked how I could help. Joey said he would go into the boy's bathroom and asked if I could somehow get Bryan to go into the bathroom. I agreed to the plan.

- I sat outside the school and waited for Bryan and Jack to get back from lunch.
- I told them about some new graffiti that was in the bathroom that they had to see.
- Bryan, Jack and I walked to the bathroom.
- When we got there I told Bryan that the graffiti was on the inside of one of the stalls.
- When Bryan entered the stall, Joey came in behind him and punched Bryan "at least 5 times in the face and neck".
- Joey said "let's go" and so we left. I just went to class.

Vice Principal Smith and I contacted **Joey Mathers** at County H.S. on 11/07/18, advised him of his Miranda Rights and he told us the following statements:

- Me and Bryan have "had beef" since school started and today I "had enough" after getting thrown out of Bryan's car for no reason.
- Bryan "had it coming to him" and "I'm not gonna let anybody dis me like that"
- Samuel always has my back, he is a good friend for helping out.
- Samuel got Bryan to come to the bathroom.
- I waited for him and "beat his ass" when he got in there.
- You guys can do whatever you want with me. I have "no regrets!"

Forensic download of Samuel Johnson's phone were placed into the evidence locker. The video quality was excellent and clearly showed that Joey kicked Bryan from behind, Bryan turned around and Joey delivered 4 left fist punches to the face and chest at which time the video stopped. I cited Joey for Assault 4 and released him to his dad.
